He was named one of the 100 Most Influential Hispanics by Hispanic Business magazine, Treasurer of the NALEO Educational Fund Board, received the New Frontier Award from the Harvard Institute of Politics and the John F. Kennedy Library Foundation, past State Representative, licensed to practice law in the State of New Mexico, and in February 2013 he became a Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE). Mr. Balderas is currently in his second term as State Auditor, and during his initial term he was the youngest Hispanic statewide elected official in the country. He has spent over seven years combating fraud, waste and abuse throughout New Mexico. This native New Mexican will be discussing all of this and what it takes to be both academically and professionally driven and reach everything he has achieved in such a short amount of time.
